

Ready Mix Driver Safety Rules

Always follow these company safety rules.

Our company, _____, is committed to the safety of our employees and customers. Our safety rules and policies are in place to prevent work-related deaths, injuries, damages, and wasteful financial losses.

We require you to follow the written safety rules below when performing work on behalf of our company. Our organization investigates all injuries, incidents, hazard reports, and property damage.

You are expected to follow these safety rules. Documented corrective action will result if the safety rules are not followed.

- Report injuries, incidents, unsafe conditions, and damage to management before your shift ends.
- Contact your supervisor whenever an injury or after-hours incident occurs or for any other business-related emergencies.
- Employees are prohibited from working while impaired by alcohol, medications, legal substances, or illicit drugs.
- Our company performs post-incident drug and alcohol screenings.
- Horseplay on the job is strictly prohibited.
- Drivers and passengers must wear seat belts when using vehicles for company business.
- Cell phone use while driving and on the job is prohibited.
- Safe and courteous driving is required. Follow speed limits. Do not tailgate and maintain a safe following distance.
- Perform a safety check of equipment and vehicles before moving. Report any maintenance concerns.
- Get out and look before backing a vehicle.
- Never back up a vehicle without a spotter.
- Backing at fuel stops, parking lots and convenience stores is prohibited.
- Safety-toe footwear is required while at work. In icy weather, use slip-over ice cleats.
- Hard hats are required at the ready-mix plant or on a construction site.
- When out of the truck, high-visibility reflective vests (day and night) and eye protection are required.
- Wear rubber gloves when working with wet cement. Wear leather or general-use gloves when handling truck equipment.
- Do not jump from vehicles. Prevent injuries by using three contact points when mounting and dismounting.
- Do not work on top vehicles or machines unless protected from falls. Use proper steps, ladders, grab bars, and work platforms.
- Scan for overhead power lines and avoid placing trucks within 10 ft of a power line.
- Lockout-tagout is required when performing maintenance on mixer equipment.
- Do not operate any machine if guards are removed.
- Do not bypass or defeat guards, safety switches or interlocks.
